ACH JOME ensemble, in collaboration with Musica Aperta Association of Bergamo and with the Orchestra Crescendo Cultural Association, promotes a *Composition workshop* – *second edition* aimed at young composers who are students of conservatories and music academies.

The Workshop will be held at the of the Cultural Association Orchestra Crescendo, in Gorgonzola (MI) in Piazza S. Francesco.

The Workshop is aimed at deepening the techniques of contemporary music writing under the guidance of two

teachers and, subsequently, with the collaboration of ACH SOME 's instrumentalists:

- Antonella Bini, flute, piccolo, sopranino flute in F with kazoo effect, flute in C, flute in G, bass flute, double bass flute
- Stefano Merighi, Bb and A clarinet, bass clarinet
- Elia Leon Mariani, violin
- Emanuele Rigamonti, cello
- Gabriele Rota, piano
- Marcello Parolini, conductor and artistic director

The Workshop will be structured as follows:

Analysis seminar on contemporary composers

2 sessions of four hours each; each session will be held during a weekend (Saturday afternoon/Sunday morning – Dates to be determined):

- The first one with an analytical focus on contemporary Italian music held by Pieralberto Cattaneo.
- The second one on contemporary European music held by Simone Fontanelli.

Composition workshop

4 meetings of 4 hours each held by the same teachers in alternation (2 for each teacher) Each teacher will hold their meetings on two consecutive days.

All meetings are group meetings.

Participants will work on composing a piece of their own. At the end of the Workshop, teachers will indicate the pieces which, on a date to be set between October and November 2025, will be the subject of in-depth study during 2 sessions - one in person over an entire weekend, the other online for consultations - with the ACHROME instrumentalists.

The Workshop also includes:

- the inclusion of some of the pieces worked on in the *Composition workshop* in the next editions of "...e adesso musica!" Season of contemporary music in Bergamo (Sala Piatti), project curated by ACHROME
- the sharing of the video recording of the performance of the pieces selected by the teachers on the ACHROME ensemble YouTube channel and on other digital platforms.

Active students/Auditors

A maximum of 8 active students are expected to take part to the 6 group meetings (including the 2 meetings of the analysis seminar).

Participation as auditors is possible.

SIMONE FONTANELLI

Since winning the prestigious VI. Salzburg International Mozart Composition Competition in 1995, Simone Fontanelli has considered as one of the most authentic contemporary musical As composer and conductor he has been invited to many international Festivals in Italy, Austria, England, Spain, Hungary, Sweden, Germany, Switzerland, Russia, Kazachistan, Israel, Taiwan. Thailand and USA. He has always received the highest praise for his works. His compositions are performed worldwide by greatest artists. In 2011 his children opera "Es war ein einmal Stück Holz" ("Once Upon A Time There was A piece Of Wood") after C. Collodi's Pinocchio, commissioned by the Cologne Gürzenich-Orchester and the Cologne Kinderoper, was a great success and currently is still performed in different European countries.

Fontanelli has received commissions from several international institutions, festivals and performing artists.

From 2003 to 2009 Mr. Fontanelli was the Director of the Gamper Festival of Contemporary Music (Brunswick, ME - USA). Since 2000 he has been on the faculty of the Mozarteum University in Salzburg where he teaches Contemporary Music Performance and, currently, is the Director of the Institut für Neue Musik.

He has been invited to give masterclasses and lectures at many important universities in Europe, Asia and USA. Since 2023 he has been on the faculty of the Accademia Chigiana in Siena.

Mr. Fontanelli was born in 1961 in Milan. He studied guitar and graduated in Composition from the Conservatorio of Milano in 1989. He also studied Philosophy at the University of Milan.

PIERALBERTO CATTANEO

Diploma in composition from the *Donizetti Musical Institute* in Bergamo with Vittorio Fellegara; degree with a Diploma of Merit in composition under Franco Donatoni from the *Accademia Chigiana* of Siena; master classes with Witold Lutoslawsky (composition), Franco Ferrara and Bruno Martinotti (conducting). Degree with honours at the *University of Bologna* with a thesis on the sacred music of Donizetti (lecturer Luigi Rognoni). Teacher of composition at *Donizetti Institute* in Bergamo (retired from November 2020).

Compositions commissioned by international festivals: Biennale Musica of Venice, Nuova Consonanza of Rome, Romaeuropa festival, Spaziomusica of Cagliari, "Trieste prima", G.A.M.O. of Florence, "Rive Gauche" of Turin, "Correnti" of Pescara (Giochi del Mediterraneo), ISCM Festival, Tage der neue Musik (Würzburg), Zagreb Biennal, C.D.M.C. of Madrid, Summer of Avignon, Autumn of Moscow, "Days of New Music" of Bacau and Chisinaw, Bucharest Festival, broadcasted by the National Radios of Italy, Germany, Hungary, Rumania, Moldavia, Spain, U.K., Poland, Yugoslavia, Russia, published and recorded by BMG Ariola, EDI-PAN, Rugginenti, Tirreno editoriale, Sinfonica, Union of Bulgarian Composers, ISCM-Italy, Stradivarius

He founded the Wind Ensemble Musica Aperta in 1976 and has conducted it in concerts not only in Italy, but abroad (Europe, U.S.A., Brazil). He founded the Chamber Orchestra of the "Incontri Europei con la Musica" in 1983; with the Wind ensemble he recorded sacred music of Donizetti and Mayr and Italian contemporary music, and, with the Orchestra, the 1st modern performance of G.S. Mayr's c minor *Stabat Mater* (Dynamic). He recorded also a CD with Bin Huang (1st Prize *Paganini*) and the orchestra "*Gli archi italiani*" and the 1st modern performance of G.S. Mayr's *Vespri per il Corpus Domini* (Bongiovanni) with "*Milano Classica*" Chamber Orchestra.

He conducts symphonic and chamber orchestras in Italy ("Haydn", Sanremo), Germany (Deutsches Kammerorchester Frankfurt), Poland (Stettino), Czech Republic ("I Virtuosi di Praga", Karlovy Vary), Hungary ("Camerata Transsylvanica"), Rumania (National Radio, Craiova, Bacau, Valcea), Moldavia (Chisinau), Egitto (Cairo Symphony Orchestra), Turchia (Adana), Corea, Canada, USA, Brazil ... in performances of classical, romantic, operatic and contemporary music, with many unpublished Italian works from XVIII and XIX centuries (Gozzini, Gasparini, Lenzi, Mayr, Coccia, Donizetti, Salvi, Piatti ...).

As musicologist he is frequently invited to international conferences on Donizetti, Mayr, Alfredo Piatti and the sacred music of the XVIII and XIX century.

PRIZE 2022 - ACH OME ensemble was formed by six talented musicians with different musical backgrounds, all active in the sphere of contemporary music. They first got together in 2013 with the friendly and valid support of the composers Davide Anzaghi, Pieralberto Cattaneo, Simone Fontanelli e Paolo Coggiola.

The Ensemble has received the appreciation of both public and critics in all the venues and musical events, in Italy and abroad, where they have appeared: Cenon/Bordeaux (France), Bacau (Romania), Milan, Bergamo, Gazzaniga, Turin, Tradate, Como, Novara, Genova...

The performances of the **ACHЯOME ensemble**, who have a keen interest in multimedia technology, are often broadcast on the digital radiosite *RADIOCEMAT*, and can be found on the YouTube channel *CMACITALY*. *CONTEMPORARY MUSIC AREA CHANNEL ITALY*, as well as in the episodes of *NoMus – live streaming*. Among the recording projects, we want to mention:

- The cd winner of the 5 stars on the MUSICA magazine VITTORIO FELLEGARA Chamber Works, recording
 of the chamber production of the composer Vittorio Fellegara, in collaboration with MusicAperta and
 NoMus, for Vermeer Classics
- **Chamber Music Works** for ensemble by D. Anzaghi (Artistic rating 4.5/5 Technical rating 4/5 for musicvoice magazine)
- *Music for Dummies Contemporary Chamber Music* (7.5 for Kathodik webzine) by the composers F. Biscione, A. Cara, P. Coggiola, both published by **Da Vinci Classic Label**.

Furthermore, **ACHIOME ensemble** has been regurlarly involved for several years in the events of the *Donizetti Opera Festival*, organized by the **Donizetti Foundation** of Bergamo, such as *Donizetti Night* and *Donizetti Christmas Day – Festival Donizetti Opera*.

ACHIOME ensemble offer itself as performer of contemporary works as well as of the historical repertoire. Working in synergy with composers, it aims to attract a public that is increasingly interested in the evolution of music through the centuries.

Thus, it devised interdisciplinary didactical-informative projects aimed at the students of the "Paolina Secco Suardo" Music High School, of the Conservatory of Bergamo, and of the "G. Verdi" Conservatory of Como.

Furthermore, precisely for these interdisciplinary projects, for some years the ensemble has had a collaboration with the Brera Accademy (Milan) for the *History of Music and Musical Theater* course, held by Prof. Roberto Favaro, this year as part of **Suono e Arte 2025**, which is receiving great participation and interest from students. The meeting, which take place in the *Sala Napoleonica* of the *Brera Academy*, takes place a san open dress rehearsal of the first concert of the **ACHHOME ensemble** season.

Their particular attention to new generations of composers increased, during the years, with the **ACHЯOME ensemble** *International Call for Scores*, which is now in its eighth edition, especially aimed at composition students from all over the world, who have always shown active participation.

With 2025 the project "...e adesso musica!"-Stagione di musica contemporanea of ACH HOME ensemble proudly reaches its ninthyear of activity thanks both to the commitment of all its members and to the great trust and support given to it by the always large and warm audience at its concerts and by those who support it in a more concrete way, rewarding, thus, the commitment and energy that the entire ensemble has shown in these first eight years of presence in the Bergamo area and beyond.
